Employment Services for the East County

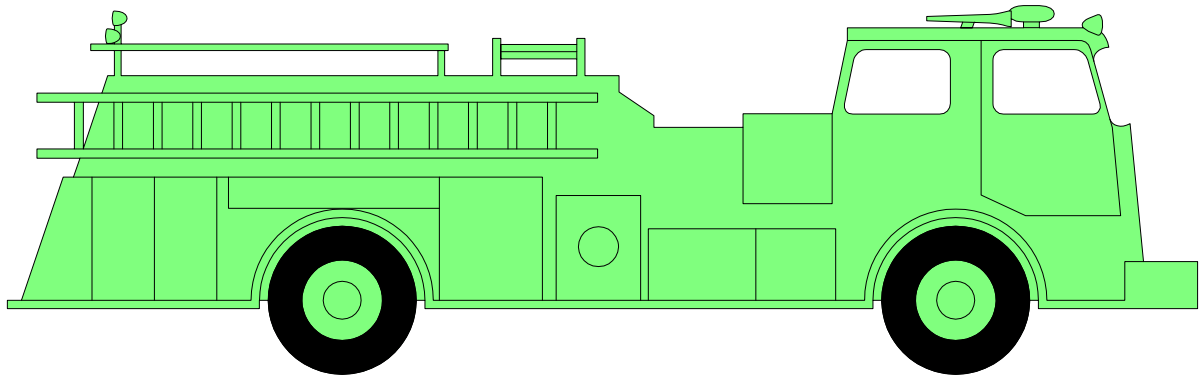
