NEIGHBORHOOD CRIME WATCH

Hillandale's Neighborhood Watch (NW) program is in a rebuilding and recruiting mode, and looking for residents to participate in a training program offered by the Montgomery County Police Department (MCPD). The training is designed to teach how to build the NW program and consists of solid project management topics: setting objectives, establishing steps to reach those objectives, enlisting neighbor support, et.al. The nine-hour program should be useful beyond NW.

The class time and location will be set around participant availability. Depending on schedules, we may decide to have nine one-hour sessions in evenings, or three three-hour sessions on weekends, etc. Choice of venue is also open: CHI, volunteers' homes, local churches, etc.

The goal is for participants in the MCPD program to put the knowledge to use as part of the Hillandale's NW program. The extent of the future commitment would be up to you and we can discuss the options.
